



How you can help the environment by not having your room serviced today

At the Hotel Grand Chancellor we understand that our operations have an impact on the environment and that it is our responsibility to take steps to achieve sound environmental performance. We want to ensure that Christchurch forever remains known as the garden city, and we have put systems in place to minimise our impact on the local environment.

We invite you to help us in our endeavours. Around your room are cards advising you on how you can contribute towards helping the environment.

We also encourage you to recycle newspapers, bottles and any other recyclables. Please place these items neatly next to your room rubbish bin and our housekeeping staff will remove and recycle. In addition to recycling by choosing not to have your room serviced on any day during your stay you can help the environment even more. Below are some of the savings your contributions can make:

- Choosing not to have your room serviced saves approximately 20 litres of water just in cleaning your bathroom
- Our laundry can save approximately 15 litres of water by simply not having your towels and linen changed
- Reduction in the use of chemicals such as toilet cleaner, multipurpose cleaner and air freshener used to clean your bathroom
- Saves power used to operate vacuum cleaners, lights and heating whilst servicing your room

Your savings enable the Hotels Green Team to participate in volunteers days working in conjunction with the Christchurch City Council on such projects as clearing old mans beard in Reuters Reserve, planting of trees at Sugar Loaf reserve and boneseed control at Barnett park. The hotel gives 25 hours bi monthly to these on going projects.
